**2010 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The Office of Victims of Crime (OVC) is offering scholarships to qualified applicants for this August 23-25, 2010 conference. Only 200 scholarships are available and only one person per double occupancy room can apply for the scholarship. Note, scholarships will not pay for single rooms. For example, if two people from the same agency are riding together and staying together, only one person will be able to receive the scholarship money. We anticipate that the demand for scholarships will far exceed the availability of the money so respond as early as possible.

Scholarships cover your mileage up to \$100.00, up to three double occupancy overnights at the Federal Government rate of \$97.00 per night and four days of Meals & Incidental Expenses (M&IE) at various rates depending upon the meals provided each day at the conference. The total M&IE for the four days is \$150.00. The scholarship will not cover the conference registration fee of \$75.00. Individuals who travel less than 50 miles one-way to the conference hotel will not be reimbursed for mileage or lodging. The mileage reimbursement rate is .50 per mile and will only be reimbursed for those driving privately owned vehicles. **Note:** Our conference staff will be making your overnight room reservations based upon the information you provide on the conference registration form.
